Ricochet of pellets	Shooters and spectators	H	Impact absorbing material at the end of the range Eye protection to be worn at all times by all persons in range when shooting is in progress	4	H4	None		
Trapping hand in gun when loading	Shooters	L	Ensure good supervision, point out this risk and way of avoiding it i.e keep hands clear of trap points when loading	4	L4	None		
Re bound eye injury	All	M	Use absorbent material behind targets to absorb Pellets(carpet) Wear eye protection. Coach Well.	4	L	none		
Misbehaviour of students	All	H	Abandon session if bad behaviour could affect the safety of the group	4	H4	None		
Cutting hands on cans	Participant	M	Heavily damaged cans should be disposed of	4	M4			

During the assessment the **severity** of the hazard was given a rating as follows

H= Could cause Death or major significant injury

M= Could cause and injury likely to last 3 days or more

L = Could result in minor injury

The **likelihood** was also given a rating based on the following
 1 = Very likely 2 = Frequent event 3= Unlikely 4 =
 Extremely unlikely
